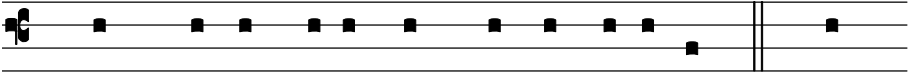

6. I stretched forth my hands to  
thee : my soul is as earth without  
water unto thee.

7. Hear me speedily, O Lord :  
my spirit hath fainted away.

8. Turn not away thy face from  
me : lest I be like unto them that  
go down into the pit.

9. Cause me to hear thy mercy  
in the morning : for in thee have  
I hoped.

10. Make the way known to  
me, wherein I should walk : for I

have lifted up my soul to thee.

11. Deliver me from my enemies, O Lord, to thee have I fled : teach me to do thy will, for thou art my God.

12. Thy good spirit shall lead me into the right land : for thy name's sake, O Lord, thou wilt quicken me in thy justice.

13. Thou wilt bring my soul out of trouble : and in thy mercy

thou wilt destroy my enemies.

14. And thou wilt cut off all them that afflict my soul : for I am thy servant.
